Investing in Professional Development

Ark has a structured approach to teacher training and professional development to help embed outstanding teaching – for trainee teachers through to executive headteachers. Ark and Ruth Miskin Training collaborate, share successes

Phonics Screening Check Results - Ark Schools vs. National Average

Phonics Screening Check Results

The partnership has been a phenomenal success. Ark schools achieve well above the national average in the phonics screening check. 93% of Year 1 pupils passed in 2016. Ark Priory and Ark Conway both achieved 100%. The national average was 81%.

Ark only has a 4% gap between pupil premium students (90%) and non-pupil premium students (94%). Nationally, there was a 14% gap between pupils eligible for free school meals and those that were not.
