

"All children progress – none get left behind."

We talked to Kelly Woodcraft, Reading Leader, about *Read Write Inc.* Phonics. Long Close School is proud to be part of Cognita Schools, a global leader in independent education.

"The training was brilliant; if you follow the simple steps, your children learn to read. It's great to have a comprehensive programme to follow that guides staff and delivers excellent results.

"As a school we love that *Read Write Inc.* Phonics is for both teachers and teaching assistants. It's a whole-school approach, so groups can stay small and teaching is pitched perfectly at the 'Goldilocks Spot' – not too hard, not too easy.

"Development Days are vital. They are bespoke. The support and guidance we receive termly from our Consultant Trainer helps fine-tune our literacy teaching. Our Trainer observes and coaches us. Online practice videos help us prepare our coaching cycle. Regular Development Days help create an atmosphere of positive feedback and improving together as a team.

"I attended two Reading Leader Training days. I used the knowledge and practices to enhance our coaching cycle, which means all reading tutors are experts and part of a culture of professional development.

needed for a handful of children for tutoring – all of whom are making strong progress.

"We have set up a good communication network with parents who are partners in their children's learning.
