1. Trains a reading leader in your school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appoints a key stage 1 or reception teacher for this role Agrees for the reading leader to attend the six-day leadership courses Attends the first day's course with your reading leader Agrees for the reading leader to coach the reading team during RWI lessons and lead a weekly 30-minute practice session Meets with reading tutors to analyse progress and agree next steps 	
2. Provides bespoke training and support in your school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Books a phonics training and support package Organises for all staff attend the two-day phonics training Organises for RWI to be taught for one hour, five days a week in Year 1 and above, and 20 minutes rising to 40 minutes a day in reception Organises for children to continue RWI until they can read with fluency – including children in later year groups who are not reading at a level commensurate with their age Timetables storytimes every day 	
3. Trains tutors to ensure success for children who need the most support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Releases teaching assistants to teach the slowest progress pupils for an additional 10 minutes every day 	
4. Introduces rigorous assessment and tracking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Organises for the reading leader to use the Online assessment to track children's reading progress every half term 	
5. Groups children effectively to ensure maximum progress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Places children into groups where they can make the most progress. This could mean children working in mix-aged groups 	
6. Uses interactive strategies for the best learning behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduces co-operative learning behaviours in all lessons 	
7. Provides extensive support for parents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Organises for RWI decodable storybooks and virtual classroom links to be sent home for pupils to practise every week
